Highwood Parking Agreement

Highwood offers limited storage of water related items for current residents. Parking is limited to boats, boat trailers, piers or other related water items as approved by the Highwood board.

No RVs, campers, commercial vehicles or snowmobile trailers.

- 1. Effective January 1, 2022 there will be a \$25.00 per year fee for EACH tag issued. Parking fees are assessed with your annual dues.
- 2. All items must have a current parking agreement and **MUST** display the Highwood identification tag. This includes all items in and out of the water.
- 3. All items are to be stored on or in the trailer/ boat. No items are to be left on the ground. This includes tires used under boats, while boats are not in the parking area during boating season. If tires are left, they will be disposed of at owners expense and privilege will be cancelled for future storage indefinitely.
- 4. All items must have current registration (if required by law) and operable.
- 5. Items must be stored in designated stalls. No parking on grass around clubhouse or picnic area.
- 6. Parking in Clubhouse parking lot is ONLY available between October 31st to May 15th
- 7. Parking on other Highwood Areas/Lots is available between October 15th and June 15th
- 8. Residents are responsible to keep the stall clean and mowed.
- 9. Highwood Association accepts no responsibility for personal items.
